

Joint Replacement Home Care Program



ONE CALL. HOME CARE FOR LIFE.



Here's how the program works...

- Once your surgery date is scheduled, and preferably no later than 72 hours prior to your hospital discharge, contact us or have the doctor's office or hospital contact us.
- A VNA nurse who will also serve as your case manager will assemble a team including a physical therapist and other professionals.



VNA care begins immediately following homecoming from the hospital and continues until you can independently leave the house for outpatient services.

- VNA will make all arrangements to ensure a safe, comfortable transition from the hospital to your home.
- Any special equipment required for your recovery (such as a hospital bed, portable commode, shower bench and other assistive devices) will be ordered and put in place prior to your arrival.
- Your VNA team will begin providing care within 24 hours of your homecoming.

The VNA Joint Replacement Home Care Team...

Nurses

A registered nurse specially trained in the after care of patients who have had joint replacement surgery will perform a clinical assessment, establish a home care plan especially for you and coordinate your care.

Physical Therapists

Physical therapy is essential following a joint replacement to restore function and improve mobility. After assessing your condition, a highly skilled therapist will begin intensive, daily one-on-one rehabilitation sessions. Your physical therapy program will include:

- A home safety evaluation to free your home of hazards that may cause a fall or injury.
- Training in proper techniques to rise from and get into bed and a chair.

One-on-one physical therapy sessions with VNA professionals are tailored to meet your needs and adjusted to keep pace with your individual progress.



- Range of motion, stretching and strengthening exercises.
- Practice walking with a walker, crutches or cane, progressing to independent mobility.

If needed, a Certified Home Health Aide will lend a hand with essential personal grooming and light housekeeping tasks.



Your therapist will report on your progress and consult with your physician. Therapy sessions will decrease in frequency as you improve and regain your ability to leave home independently.

Certified Home Health Aides

If needed, an aide trained in post-orthopedic surgery care will lend a hand with essential personal grooming and light housekeeping tasks. Your aide will also be trained by the physical therapist to assist with your exercise regimen.

Occupational Therapists

If recommended by your physical therapist and approved by your doctor, a skilled occupational therapist can help you to regain upper body strength and improve your ability to perform essential daily tasks such as dressing and bathing.
